Materials Management	PABCO Paper has always produced paper using 100% recycled fiber. The majority of the fiber comes from local sources, minimizing the impact from material movement. Over the last decade-and-a-half, PABCO has reduced the weight of its core product paper, thus reducing fiber requirements by almost ten thousand tons per year.
Efficiency of Production and Energy Consumption	PABCO uses computer-controlled production technology to minimize the overuse of materials. Heat energy is recycled wherever possible in the production process, to reduce energy consumption. Over the last decade-and-a-half, PABCO has reduced energy use per unit of production by over twenty-five percent.
Efficient Materials Management through Recycling	PABCO works with many of its customers to reuse materials used for the packaging and shipping of its product, as well as scrap produced in conversion.
Culture of Environmental Sensitivity and Social Responsibility	Our goal is to make all our employees more environmentally sensitive and to develop a culture within the organization. And as we employ mostly from the local communities our hope is that they will take this knowledge and culture with them and into their communities to be promoted in an ethical and sustainable manner.
